Dear HS Stakeholders,

It is the intent of Danville High School, and our District to lessen the risk of health issues for our students. With this intent and our mission to educate the students of our district, we have devised the following plans.

- Plan 4: **Fully Remote**
 - All of our students are on remote learning; students complete their work at home. Teachers will communicate with students primarily through Schoology and Google Suite (gmail, drive, classroom).
 - Athletics may be limited and/or canceled as determined by District Administration and KPH
 - Criteria for this is:
 - Risk level 4 (Purple) as determined by **ODH/KPH**.
 - Risk level 1-3 and a lack of staffing to adequately meet the needs of students.

- Plan 3: **Blended Learning A** (Teachers move)
 - Remote learning is the sole discretion of the school. If parents want to request it, adequate academic progress needs to be maintained by the student (if grades are not kept up, the school will require them to return to the building).
 - Athletics may be limited and/or canceled as determined by District Administration and KPH
 - Students will enter the building, maintaining social distancing, and report directly to their homeroom.
 - Facial coverings are required for all students.
 - To varying degrees, teachers may switch classes, with students remaining in their homerooms.
 - Schoology and Google Suite (gmail, meets, classroom, drive) are the primary means of communication with students.
 - Staff will be on campus from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
 - Students will enter the building beginning at 7:40 a.m. (teachers in rooms at that time) and exit starting at 1:30 p.m.
 - Buses will release students off the bus at different times to ensure better social distancing.
 - Students are to directly leave the building unless given prior approval to report to another location on campus.
 - Criteria for this is:

- Risk level 2-4 (Orange, Red, and Purple) as determined by **ODH/KPH**.
 - Groups of students may be asked to learn remotely based upon a lack of staffing to adequately meet students' needs.

- Plan 2: **Blended Learning B** (students move)
 - Remote learning is the sole discretion of the school. If parents want to request it, adequate academic progress needs to be maintained by the student (if grades are not kept up, then the school will require the student to return to the building).
 - Athletics may be limited and/or canceled as determined by District Administration and KPH
 - Students will enter the building, maintaining social distancing, and report directly to their 1st period class.
 - Students will move through the building. Maintaining a double barrier (barriers are facial coverings and social distancing).
 - Schoology and Google Suite (gmail, meets, classroom, drive) are the primary means of communication with students.
 - Staff will be on campus from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
 - Students will enter the building beginning at 7:40 a.m. (teachers in rooms at that time) and exit starting at 1:30 p.m.
 - Buses will release students off the bus at different times to ensure better social distancing.
 - Students are to directly leave the building unless given prior approval to report to another location on campus.
 - Criteria for this is:
 - Risk level 2-4 (Orange, Red, and Purple)) as determined by **ODH/KPH**.
 - Individual homerooms, classes, and grade levels may be asked to learn remotely based on a lack of staffing to meet the needs of students adequately.

- Plan 1: **Modified Traditional**
 - Remote learning is not an option; all students are required to return.
 - The school day is 8:05 a.m.-3:00 p.m.
 - Facial coverings are required for all students while at Risk level 1.
 - Students will follow their schedules and travel through the building.
 - Lunches will occur in the lobby.
 - Criteria for this is:
 - Risk level 0-2 as determined by **ODH/KPH**.

Remote Learning - Delivery of online instruction whereby the student has some element of control over time, place, path, or pace of learning.

Blended Learning - The delivery of instruction in a combination of time in a supervised location away from home and online delivery whereby the student has some element of control over time, place, path, or place of learning.
