# Continuation Plan

Dear Elementary Stakeholders,

It is the intent of Danville Elementary School, and our District, to lessen the risk of health issues for our students and staff. With this intent and mission to educate the students of our district, we have devised the following plans. There are no new changes from our current operation.

One of the most pressing issues is quarantining both staff and students. Quarantines are taxing to all of us academically and socially and they have the potential to create situations where remote learning is required due to lack of staffing. Homerooms and buses may be asked to remain home for remote learning for these sorts of reasons.

- Plan 3: **Fully Remote**
  - All of our students are on remote learning; students complete their work at home. Teachers will communicate with students primarily through Schoology and Google Classroom.
  - Criteria for this is:
    - As mandated by the State of Ohio
  
- Plan 2: **Blended Learning/In Person Learning/Remote Learning for a limited time**
  - Remote learning is the sole discretion of the school. If parents want to request it, adequate academic progress needs to be maintained by the student (if grades are not kept up, the school will require them to return to the building).
  - We will continue to offer both remote learning and in person learning. Because the covid numbers are rising, once a student chooses remote, they may not return to in person learning until the beginning of the next quarter. The only exception to this is if they are academically failing, as mentioned above.
  - Students will continue to enter the building, maintaining social distancing, and report directly to their homeroom where their temperature is taken, etc.
  - Facial coverings are required for all students K thru 6th grades. Two masks are requested so in times where the first is soiled (mucus from a sneeze, accidentally thrown in the trash, etc.).
  - Fourth thru 6th grade teachers may switch classes, with students remaining in their homerooms. (Teachers move)
  - 2nd and 3rd grades will continue to remain with their teacher all day.
  - Kindergarten and 1st grades will continue to social distance in two split classrooms.
  - PreSchool will continue their Monday/Wednesday/every other Friday and Tuesday/Thursday/every other Friday schedules.

- Students will enter the building beginning at 7:40 a.m. and exit starting at 1:25 p.m. (Car riders and bus riders first, followed by walkers around 1:35pm)
  - Recess will continue in smaller numbers and interacting only with their classmates.
  - Breakfast and lunch will continue to be eaten in the classrooms.
  - Students will attend PE as scheduled. Students will check out library books. We hope to incorporate other specials as we can.
  - Criteria for this is:
    - Risk level 2-4 (Orange, Red, and Purple) as determined by **ODH/KPH**.
    - Groups of students may be asked to learn remotely based upon a lack of staffing to adequately meet students' needs.
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- Plan 1: **Modified Traditional**
    - Remote learning is not an option; all students are required to return.
    - The school day is 8:05 a.m.-3:00 p.m.
    - Facial coverings are required for all students while at Risk level 1.
    - Students will follow their schedules and travel through the building.
    - Lunches will occur in the cafeteria.
    - Criteria for this is:
      - Risk level 0-2 as determined by **ODH/KPH**.
